



## CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- Encourage your child to learn the rules of Hockey and play within them
- Discourage unfair play and never argue with officials during a game these may be discussed later in a calm atmosphere.
- Help your child recognise good performance, not just results
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
- Publicly accept officials, umpires judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their Hockey.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Endeavour to become an active member of the club, use the facilities and get to know other parents.
